

Does the JetBlue refund money if the flight is delayed or rescheduled?

JetBlue does offer refund options when a flight is significantly delayed or rescheduled, and understanding exactly when you can get your money back helps you make informed decisions if your travel plans change unexpectedly +1-855-738-4113. If JetBlue changes your flight schedule, such as by rescheduling departure times by several hours or rerouting your trip, you may be eligible for a full refund, especially when the new itinerary does not work for you +1-855-738-4113.
