The Birmingham-Jefferson County Transit Authority announced today that it will join with other transit systems across the country to participate in the 12th annual event designed to promote public transportation.

"We look forward to this event every year because we get a chance to encourage those who would normally drive a car to try public transportation," said BJCTA Executive Director, Barbara Murdock. The American Public Transportation Association (APTA) started sponsoring the effort in 2006 when gas prices were \$3 per gallon. According to APTA, every \$1 invested in public transportation generates approximately \$4 in economic returns, powering community growth and revitalization.
