Track your bus with MAX MyStop

(Birmingham, AL) – Want to grab that extra cup of coffee but wondering when the next bus will arrive? There is no need to worry at all thanks to a new live tracking service. The Birmingham-Jefferson County Transit Authority (BJCTA) today announced that “MAX MyStop”, is now available.

It's easy to use from a smartphone, tablet or computer. Just log on to www.maxtransit.org or download the free “mystop” app on any iPhone/Android device. Simply click on the route and the stop to see where the bus is and when it will arrive. Once on the bus, use our free Wi-Fi and MAX MyStop to determine the length of the trip.

Bus location data, route information, schedules and maps all come together with this new online tool. Customers can plan a trip and schedule text messages that will show information about their favorite routes or stops. Rider alerts will detail delays or detours that may affect a trip.

“This is an exciting time. We are removing the guesswork from any bus trip by using “MAX MyStop”. The real-time arrival information is just one more way we are working to improve our service,” said Barbara Murdock, BJCTA Executive Director.
