

Homewood Route Changes - FAQs

Why are these bus stops being removed?

BJCTA is making service changes due to reduced funding from the City of Homewood's Fiscal Year 2026 budget.

Because of this funding reduction, BJCTA must remove several bus stops within Homewood beginning October 27, 2025.

This decision was not made internally by BJCTA but rather reflects the budget levels established by the City of Homewood

How were these stops selected for removal?

Stops were evaluated based on:

- Low ridership usage
- Close proximity to other stops (less than 1/8 mile apart)
- Safety and accessibility concerns (visibility, crosswalks, sidewalk conditions)
- Impact on travel time and reliability

How far will I have to walk to the next available stop?

Most riders will only need to walk an additional 1–3 minutes (roughly one to two blocks) to the next nearest stop. MAX Transit ensures that stop spacing remains convenient and accessible.

Which bus stops are being removed?

The following stops are scheduled for removal in the Homewood area:

When will these stops be removed?

The stop removals are planned to take effect October 27. Updated route maps and schedules will be available at maxtransit.org and at the Central Station Customer Service Desk.

Why can't BJCTA continue operating these stops without City funding?

Public transportation services depend on local, state, and federal funding. Each municipality determines how much to contribute toward service within its city limits. BJCTA cannot continue operating routes or stops in areas that are no longer funded by the local jurisdiction.

How can I find my nearest active bus stop?

You can:

How will this affect riders?

While these stop removals will reduce access in certain areas of Homewood, BJCTA remains committed to helping riders connect to other services throughout the region. No other city routes are changing at this time.

1. Most riders will still have access to MAX Transit routes within a short walking distance.
2. Riders can plan alternate travel using the MAX Trip Planner or the Mobile App.

Will this change my route or schedule?

Depends. Bus routes and schedules will not change. Only certain stop locations are being removed to improve travel time and efficiency.
