Step-by-Step: Getting Your United Boarding Pass

1. Using Online Check-In

Online check-in opens 24 hours before your scheduled departure.

Steps:

Go to [United.com](https://www.united.com)

Click Check In

Enter your details

Choose mobile or print format

You'll receive your boarding pass immediately after completing check-in.

2. Through the United Airlines App

The United app is the easiest way to access your boarding pass on the go.

With the app, you can:

View your boarding pass anytime

Add it to Apple Wallet / Google Wallet

See gate changes and boarding group alerts

Recheck your pass with one tap

3. At the Airport

You can print your boarding pass at:

United self-service kiosks

United ticketing counters

Perfect for passengers who forgot to check in online or prefer printed documents.

Common Problems & Easy Fixes

! Mobile boarding pass not appearing

Restart the app, reconnect to Wi-Fi, or reinstall the app.

! Name mismatch

Make sure the name on your reservation matches your ID.

! International travel documents missing

Upload your passport or visa in the United app.

Technical errors

A kiosk or customer service agent can reprint your pass immediately.

If none of these work, call +1-855-738-4041 for fast troubleshooting.

Pro Travel Tips for United Flyers

Always screenshot your mobile boarding pass

Keep your ID ready at the first security checkpoint

Save boarding documents in your phone's wallet

Carry a backup printed copy for international itineraries

Check your gate frequently in the app
