Types of Pets Allowed

United makes room for:

- Small **cats**, **dogs**, and certain **household birds** in the cabin 
 - Larger pets in the **temperature-controlled cargo area**  
 - *However*, exotic pets, reptiles, and restricted species aren't permitted for safety reasons.  
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Cabin Pet Rules

If your pet is joining you inside the aircraft:

- They must stay inside a soft-sided or hard-sided **carrier** under the seat ahead of you.
- Max carrier size: **17" L × 10" W × 9" H**  
- Bring something comforting like a toy or blanket 

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Pet Fees & Reservations

- Cabin pet fee is typically **\$125 per pet**.
- Cargo fees vary depending on destination and pet size.
- Booking early is essential — limited pets per flight! 📅✈️

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Cargo Pet Travel

For pets too big for in-cabin travel:

- They travel in **climate-controlled cargo spaces** 🌡️🐶
 - Carriers must be sturdy, ventilated, and approved.
 - Pre-booking is required — availability is limited! 🐶✈️
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Required Documents

Make sure you're prepared:

- Proof of **rabies vaccination** for cats and dogs 
 - A **health certificate** from a vet — often needed within 10 days of travel 
 - Additional rules apply for **international** flights 
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Pet Safety Tips

- Hydrate your pet well before traveling 
 - Avoid sedation unless a vet clearly recommends it 
 - Label carriers with **contact info & your pet's name** 
 - Keep familiar toys or blankets handy 
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FAQs

Q1: Can I bring more than one pet?

Only **one cabin pet per passenger** is allowed.

Q2: Maximum pet weight?

Pet + carrier should be **under 20 lbs.**

Q3: Weather restrictions?

Yes — extreme heat or cold can affect **cargo** travel.

Q4: Do emotional support animals travel free?

United treats ESAs the same as regular pets under current policy.
