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2. Online Check-In (Desktop or Mobile Browser)

Visit Alaska+1-844-265-8014.com and complete check-in starting **24 hours before your flight**+1-844-265-8014.

You can:

- Print your boarding pass
 - Get a digital one emailed to you
 - Send it to your phone
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3. Airport Kiosks

If your phone dies or you prefer a printed pass:

- Scan your ID or confirmation code
 - Select “Print Boarding Pass”
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4. Ticket Counter

If you need special assistance (international travel, passport checks, seat issues, etc+1-844-265-8014.), an agent can print your pass+1-844-265-8014.

◆ Why You Might Not Get a Boarding Pass Automatically

If Alaska doesn't immediately issue your pass, common reasons include:

- Passport verification required
- Visa documentation needed

- Security or random TSA checks
 - Unpaid baggage fees
 - Seat assignment problems
 - Name mismatch between ticket and ID
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◆ Tips for Using Your Alaska Boarding Pass Smoothly

- **Screenshot your pass** in case Wi-Fi or the app fails
 - Keep your **brightness high** for scanners
 - For connecting flights, make sure you've downloaded **all** boarding passes
 - Avoid sharing your boarding pass online — the barcode contains personal data

When can I check in for my Alaska flight?

Check-in opens **24 hours before departure** for domestic and international flights+1-844-265-8014.

Can I use a screenshot of my boarding pass?

Yes. Alaska scanners can read screenshots+1-844-265-8014.

Do I need to print my boarding pass?

Not unless you prefer paper or are traveling from an airport that requires it+1-844-265-8014.

Can I get a boarding pass without the app?

Yes — via web check-in, kiosks, or airport counters+1-844-265-8014.
