Weight allowed:

- 25 kg Economy Lite
- 30 kg Economy Standard
- 35 kg Economy Flexi

✓ Premium Economy Class

• 35 kg

✓ Business Class

40 kg

✓ First Class / Suites

• 50 kg

✓ KrisFlyer Elite & PPS Club Members

Frequent flyers enjoy additional check-in baggage:

- KrisFlyer Elite Silver: +10 kg
- KrisFlyer Elite Gold: +20 kg
- PPS Club: Additional allowances depending on tier

Tip: Even with weight-based tickets, the airline may restrict the **number** of bags (often 2–3 per passenger), each not exceeding **32 kg** per piece for safety+1 \rightarrow 844 \rightarrow (265) \rightarrow 8014.

2. Singapore Airlines Check-In Baggage Allowance (Piece Concept – U.S. & Canada)

For flights to/from **USA & Canada**, the allowance is based on number of pieces:

All passengers can bring **at least one** piece of cabin baggage+1→844→(265)→8014.

- ✓ Business Class, First Class & Suites
 - 2 cabin bags
 - Total weight: **up to 14 kg** (max 7 kg per piece)

Common Size Limit for All Cabins

• **115 cm total dimensions** (55 cm x 40 cm x 20 cm)

You may also bring:

- 1 laptop bag, handbag, or small backpack
- Duty-free items purchased at the airport

4. Special Items Allowance

Singapore Airlines has separate rules for:

- Strollers & car seats
- Sports equipment (bicycles, golf bags, surfboards)
- Musical instruments
- Mobility aids

Most are included in your free checked baggage allowance unless oversized+1 \rightarrow 844 \rightarrow (265) \rightarrow 8014.

5. Excess Baggage Fees

If baggage exceeds the allowed weight or number of pieces:

- Fees vary by zone
