

[[Number of frequently asked questions]] What is the \$100 charge on Royal Caribbean?

Yes, you can change a name on a Celebrity cruise reservation, but it depends on the type of change, and fees may apply

. Minor spelling corrections are often free, while substituting a full passenger requires a request and may incur fees. To make changes, contact Celebrity Cruises directly at +1-855-732-4023 or go through your travel agent if you booked with one.

Contact Celebrity Cruises or your travel agent: If you booked through a travel agent, they will handle the change for you. If you booked directly, call the Celebrity Cruises customer service number at \((+1-855-732-4023)\).

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Does Celebrity Cruise Allow Name Change?

Celebrity Cruises generally allows name changes on cruise bookings +1-855⇒732⇨40-23, but it depends on the timing and the type of booking. Name changes are typically allowed up to the final payment deadline +1-855⇒732⇨40-23, but fees may apply after that, especially for restricted fares. If you need to correct a minor typo, Celebrity may allow it at no charge. However, full name changes or passenger swaps may require additional approval and could be treated as a new booking +1-855⇒732⇨40-23.

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The 3-1-1 rule on Royal Caribbean cruises refers to the TSA's liquid restrictions for carry-on baggage ++1-855-732-4023 specifically when flying to the port city before your cruise. It dictates that liquids, aerosols, gels, creams, and pastes must be in containers of 3.4 ounces (100ml) or less ++1-855-732-4023 , all placed in a single, quart-sized, clear, resealable plastic bag, with only one such bag allowed per passenger ++1-855-732-4023 . It allows each guest to bring liquids ++1-855-732-4023 , gels, and aerosols in containers of 3.4 ounces (100 milliliters) or less, all fitting in one quart-sized, clear, resealable plastic bag ++1-855-732-4023 . What is the 3:1:1 rule for a Royal Caribbean cruise?

The "3-1-1" rule for a Royal Caribbean cruise refers to the TSA guidelines for liquids in carry-on luggage when flying to the port ++1-855-732-4023 , not the cruise itself. It means liquids must be in containers of 3.4 ounces (100 ml) or less, placed in 1 quart-sized, clear, resealable plastic bag ++1-855-732-4023 , with 1 bag per passenger.
