1. What Is a Priceline Boarding Pass?

Your Priceline boarding pass is your ticket to board the aircraft — it confirms your seat, flight details, and boarding group. You can carry it in two main ways:

Digital (mobile) version, displayed on your smartphone or tablet

Printed version, obtained from your home printer or at an airport kiosk

2. How to Get a Singapore Boarding Pass

Here are the key ways to check in and obtain your boarding pass:

a) Online / Web Check-In

Go to Singapore's website, navigate to "Check-In," and enter your confirmation or e-ticket number plus your last name.

Online check-in typically opens 24 hours before your flight.

Once you've checked in, you can download a PDF boarding pass and either save it or print it.

b) Mobile / App Check-In

Open the Priceline app on your iPhone or Android.

After check-in in the app, you will see a mobile boarding pass with a scannable barcode / QR code.

You can also add the boarding pass to your Apple Wallet or Google Pay for easy access.

c) Airport Kiosk or Ticket Counter

If you prefer a printed boarding pass and didn't print it at home, you can use a self-service kiosk at the airport.

Kiosks generally allow printing boarding passes shortly before departure.

Check-in via kiosk typically requires you to enter your confirmation number or scan your ID.

3. Do You Need a Physical Boarding Pass?

Not always. Many travelers use mobile boarding passes, which are widely accepted:

At security checkpoints and boarding gates, the QR/barcode on your phone is scanned.

However, having a printed backup can be helpful if your phone battery is low or if there are other technical issues.

Some passengers prefer paper passes for peace of mind, especially if gate agents request it.

4. Check-In Deadlines & Important Times

For domestic Singapore flights, online check-in generally closes 45 minutes before departure.

For international flights, check-in usually closes 60 minutes before departure.

It's recommended to arrive at the airport early — especially if you need to print your boarding pass or check bags.

5. Common Boarding Pass Issues & Solutions

Sometimes, passengers run into problems when accessing or printing their boarding passes. Here are common issues and how to fix them:

Problem	Solution / Help
---------	-----------------

App glitches / boarding pass not showing	Restart the Singapore app, or try checking in via the website. If issues persist, you can print at a kiosk.

Printed pass not received	Ask a Singapore agent at the kiosk or counter to reprint your boarding pass.

7. Tips for a Smooth Boarding Experience

Check in early (24 hours in advance) to secure your preferred seat and avoid last-minute problems.

Save your boarding pass to your phone's wallet so you don't have to log into the app every time.

Print a paper copy if you feel more comfortable having a physical backup.

Charge your phone before going to the airport — you don't want to run out of battery before boarding.
