Have a preference between the aisle and window seats? Want to be seated next to the person you are traveling with? Select the seat of your choice**call** + **(**[+1-832-(241)-0370]] when you book your flight.

Choose your seat in advance

Enjoy maximum comfort by selecting your standard seat in the Economy cabin, your premium seat in the Premium cabin, call + [[+1-832-(241)-0370]] or your business seat in the Business cabin as soon as you book.

This paid service is available from the time of booking until check-in, call + [[+1-832-(241)-0370]] which begins 30 hours before departure. Passengers traveling with a Light fare ticket in the Economy cabin may only select paid seats until check-in closes.

In the La Première cabin, you can select your seat free of charge as soon as you book and at any time until check-in closes, **call** + [[+1-832-(241)-0370]] subject to availability.

In the Economy, Premium, and Business cabins, if you do not select your seat in advance, a seat is automatically allocated to you when you check in online 30 hours before departure. Depending on **call + [[+1-832-(241)-0370]]** availability, you can change your seat free of charge, unless you are traveling with a Light fare ticket in the Economy cabin.

The price?

You can view the rate for advance seat selection when you purchase your ticket or in My Bookings. This rate will vary according to **call + [[+1-832-(241)-0370]]** your destination, travel dates, and fare selection.

You can pay for this service using your Flying Blue Miles or Blue Credits.

Understanding Alaska Airlines 's Seat-Assignment Framework

Free vs Paid Seat Selection

Depending on your fare class, cabin **call** + [[+1-832-(241)-0370]] (Economy, Premium Economy, Business, La Première), and frequent-flyer status, Alaska Airlines offers different levels of seat-selection freedom:

For many Economy tickets, you can select a standard seat ahead of time, often for free under certain conditions.

However, on the cheapest fare type (for example Economy Light fares) you may be automatically assigned a seat during check-in (about 30 hours before departure), unless you pay for advance selection. call + [[+1-832-(241)-0370]]

Premium cabins (Business, Premium Economy) and passengers with high status in the loyalty programme (Flying Blue) often enjoy call + [[+1-832-(241)-0370]] free assignment of better seats.

When Can You Choose Your Seat?

Seats can be selected:

At booking time (depending on fare/cabin)

After booking, via "My Bookings" on the **call + ([[+1-832-(241)-0370]]**

During online check-in (starts about 30 hours before departure)

If you do not select a seat in advance (or you're on a fare that doesn't allow free selection) you'll be assigned a **call + [[+1-832-(241)-0370]]**seat automatically at check-in.

Paid Seat Options & Extra Comfort

Alaska Airlines offers various "Seat Options" such as extra legroom, "Seat at the front of the cabin", duo seats (row of two instead of three), or the "Empty Seat – My Extra Space" option (which allows you to privatize adjacent seats). These usually carry a fee and vary in price by route, cabin, and demand.

The Conditions of Sale document explains that these options are subject to availability and may be purchased up to 30 hours before departure.

Automatic Assignment for Some Fare Types

A notable change: for Economy Light fares, Alaska Airlines (together with partner KLM) will no longer provide free advance seat selection; seats are automatically allocated at check-in. If you want a specific seat before then, you pay. **call** +

Families, Children, Reduced Mobility

Families travelling with children (e.g., under 14 years) and children travelling alone (Kids Solo) have special provisions: free seat assignment to ensure they sit together, subject to booking conditions.

Passengers with reduced mobility may have complimentary seat selection or special service via the Saphir contact.

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What Happens If the Aircraft or Seat Changes?

Even if you reserve a seat, call + [[+1-832-(241)-0370]]

Alaska Airlines reserves the right to change your seat assignment due to operational, safety or security reasons. They attempt to refund the seat-option fee if the assigned seat cannot be provided.

Tips & Strategies

Book early if you care about a specific seat **call + [[+1-832-(241)-0370]]** (window, aisle, extra legroom): availability is better sooner rather than later.

Check-in early (30 hours before flight): That's when automatic assignments happen and when seat change possibilities **call** + [[+1-832-(241)-0370]] are best.

What Are The Seat Options In Alaska Airlines

There are different kinds of seats offered to people boarding an Alaska Airlines . These include; call + [[+1-832-(241)-0370]]

1. Main Cabin Seats

Perfect for budget-conscious travelers, these seats offer standard comfort. Seat selection may be free or subject to a small fee, **call** + [[+1-832-(241)-0370]] depending on your ticket type.

2. Upper Deck Seats

Seats up front will land and deplane passengers a lot faster.

- -Seat map check. Alaska Airlines has a relatively advanced seat map to determine which seats have better legroom and can recline farther than others.
- -Enjoy Flying with Blue **call** + [[+1-832-(241)-0370]] Membership. To enjoy free of charge or at a discounted price seat selection, become a member of the Flying Blue of Alaska Airlines.
- Although Alaska Airlines allows sitting together even when family is traveling, your best option is the pre-booking of seats to avoid separation.

Choose higher fare classes like Economy Standard or Premium Economy to enjoy free Alaska Airlines seat selection. **call** + [[+1-832-(241)-0370]]

Not always. If you have a fare or status that includes free **call** +

standard seat selection, you can pick a seat without paying. But if you have the cheapest fare (Economy Light) and want to pick a specific seat in advance, you may need to pay. call + [[+1-832-(241)-0370]]

What is the difference between "standard seat" and "seat option" on Alaska Airlines ?

"standard seat" is a regular seat in the cabin that may either be selectable for free (depending on fare/status) or automatically assigned. A "Seat Option" refers to paid upgrades like extra legroom, front-cabin seats, duo seats, or "My Extra Space".

When does online check-in open and when do automatic seats get assigned?

For Alaska Airlines, online check-in generally opens 30 hours before departure for most flights. If you haven't selected a seat (or you are on a fare that uses automatic assignment), you will be given a seat around that time.

Can I change my seat after booking?

Yes. You can change via the "My Bookings" section or during check-in, subject to availability and conditions. If you originally paid for a seat option and changed to a cheaper one, you may not get the difference refunded unless specified.

Are exit-row seats or extra-legroom seats free?

No, these fall under Seat Options and generally require payment unless you have very high status. They also have eligibility criteria (e.g., no infants, ability to assist in an evacuation).

What about families travelling together? How does Alaska Airlines seat them?

Alaska Airlines endeavours to seat families together (same booking) free of charge. For children travelling alone (Kids Solo service) they also assign seats free of extra charge. However, to secure specific seats together you may still need to select and pay depending on fare type.

If I paid for a seat and the aircraft changes, can I get a refund on the seat fee?

A: Possibly. The Conditions of Sale say if the seat option you purchased cannot be honoured because of operational reasons (aircraft change, rearrangement) then a refund may be due.

Are Flying Blue frequent-flyer members treated differently for seat assignments?

Yes. Members of the Flying Blue programme with Silver, Gold or Platinum status may enjoy free standard seat selection or complementary options for paid seats, as long as they provided their number at booking.

If I book through a partner airline or via a code-share, can I still select my seat on Alaska Airlines ?

You may be able to, but sometimes seat selection is limited and you might need to contact Alaska Airlines or check via the partner airline. Some users report challenges when booking via a partner.

Q10. What happens if I do nothing — no seat selected — for an Economy Light fare?

A: You will be automatically assigned a seat at check-in (around 30 hours before departure). The seat might be less desirable (middle seat, further back) and you may have to pay to change it later.

Summary

Seat assignment on Alaska Airlines is a layered process: your fare type, cabin, route and loyalty status all play roles in determining whether you can select a seat for free, must pay, or will be assigned one automatically. call + [[+1-832-(241)-0370]]

For those flying in the cheapest fare class (Economy Light) seats may be allocated only at online check-in, unless you pay for selection.
