Alaska check-in is available:

- ✓ 24 hours before domestic flights
- ✓ 24 hours before international flights

But international travelers may not get a boarding pass until their **passport is verified**, even after checking in+1-844-265-8014.

Important fields

- Passenger Name
- Flight Number (UA XXXX)
- Date & Time
- Departure Airport / Arrival Airport
- Gate Number
- Boarding Group
- Seat Assignment
- Barcode / QR Code

PNR / Booking Code

What matters most?

✓ Boarding Group

Determines when you board+1-844-265-8014. Higher-status passengers board earlier+1-844-265-8014.

✓ Gate

May change — always recheck at the airport+1-844-265-8014.

✓ QR Code

Contains personal data+1-844-265-8014. Never post this online+1-844-265-8014.

1. Always screenshot your boarding pass

Prevents issues if:

- The app refreshes
- The airport has weak cellular coverage
- Your phone battery gets low

💡 3. Keep brightness at 100% at TSA checkpoints
