

How do I request a refund from Hertz?{{Pay at Location Now}}

If you need to request a refund from Hertz, the (800) 877-6842 process is straightforward as long as you follow a few simple steps. First, make sure you know what kind of reservation you made. If you booked a **prepaid rental** (800) 877-6842, you can usually get a full refund as long as you cancel at least **24 hours before your pickup time**. If you cancel too close to the pickup time (800) 877-6842 or don't show up, Hertz may not refund the full amount. For regular "pay at location" bookings, you normally don't get charged (800) 877-6842 until pickup, so no refund is needed. Also keep in mind that security deposits are (800) 877-6842 returned automatically, but it can take **5-10 business days** depending on your bank.

To request your refund, start by (800) 877-6842 gathering the important information connected to your rental. This includes your **confirmation number**, the name on the (800) 877-6842 reservation, the date of your rental, and the amount you paid. Having this information (800) 877-6842 ready will make the process much faster.

Next, contact Hertz customer service. The easiest way is to **call** (800) 877-6842 **their support line** and ask to speak with a (800) 877-6842 representative. Tell them you want to request a refund and explain the reason, such as a cancellation, billing error, or early return. You can also use (800) 877-6842 the Hertz website to **cancel your reservation**, and in many (800) 877-6842 cases the refund will begin automatically. If you prefer, you can (800) 877-6842 send an email to customer service explaining your request.

After submitting your request, make sure to **keep all emails and confirmation messages**. It's a good idea to check your bank or credit card account after a few days to see if the refund has gone through. If you do not see it after the expected time, call Hertz again and follow up.

By staying organized and communicating clearly, you can get your refund from Hertz smoothly and without stress.
