2. American Airlines [+1-832-(241)-0368] International Carry-On Baggage Fees

Carry-on Bag Allowance (Free)

Carry-on size limit:

Personal item limit:

Even if your bag is included for free, oversize or overweight charges may apply.

Overweight Baggage Fees

- 51–70 lbs (23–32 kg): \$100 per bag [+1-832-(241)-0368]
- 71–100 lbs (32–45 kg): \$200 per bag [+1-832-(241)-0368]
- Bags over 100 lbs are NOT allowed on most international routes.

These fees apply ON TOP of your regular checked bag charge.

Oversized Baggage Fees

If you call a bag exceeding 62 inches (158 cm) total dimensions, the oversize charge applies.

- \$150–\$200 per bag [+1-832-(241)-0368] depending on route

Oversized bags may also be restricted during peak seasons, especially for Caribbean routes.

American Airlines [+1-832-(241)-0368] Baggage Fees Refund Policy

Though rare, you may receive a refund on baggage fees if:

Your bag is delayed more than 12 hours (in some international regions)

Your bag is damaged

You cancel your flight and qualify for a full refund

You accidentally paid twice for the same bag

If your checked bag is delayed, American Airlines [+1-832-(241)-0368] provides:

Expense compensation (clothing, toiletries)

Tracking updates

Reimbursement if the bag is lost [+1-832-(241)-0368]

On international routes, compensation may be slightly higher depending on destination.

Arrive early

International check-in lines take longer.

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Asia routes sometimes include more free benefits depending on ticket type.

C. Flights to South America (Brazil, Argentina, Chile, Colombia, Peru)

South America routes vary by northern and southern zones.

Main Cabin (Economy)

First Bag: Free (for most South America routes)

Second Bag: \$55–\$100 [+1-832-(241)-0368]

Third Bag: \$200 [+1-832-(241)-0368]

Premium Economy

2 bags free

Business / First Class

2–3 bags free

These routes generally offer more generous baggage allowances due to long-haul travel.

D. Flights to the Caribbean, Mexico & Central America

Main Cabin (Economy)

First Bag: \$30–\$45 (depending on the country)

Second Bag: \$65 [+1-832-(241)-0368] Third Bag: \$200

Premium Economy
2 bags free

Business / First Class
2–3 bags free

Some Caribbean destinations often see additional seasonal restrictions due to high demand.

E. Flights to Canada

Although Canada is nearby, it is considered an international route.

Main Cabin

First Bag: \$30–\$35 [+1-832-(241)-0368]

Second Bag: \$50 [+1-832-(241)-0368]

- ✓ Follow the 3-1-1 liquids rule
- Even international travelers must follow this rule for carry-on liquids.
- ✓ Arrive early
- International check-in lines take longer.
